

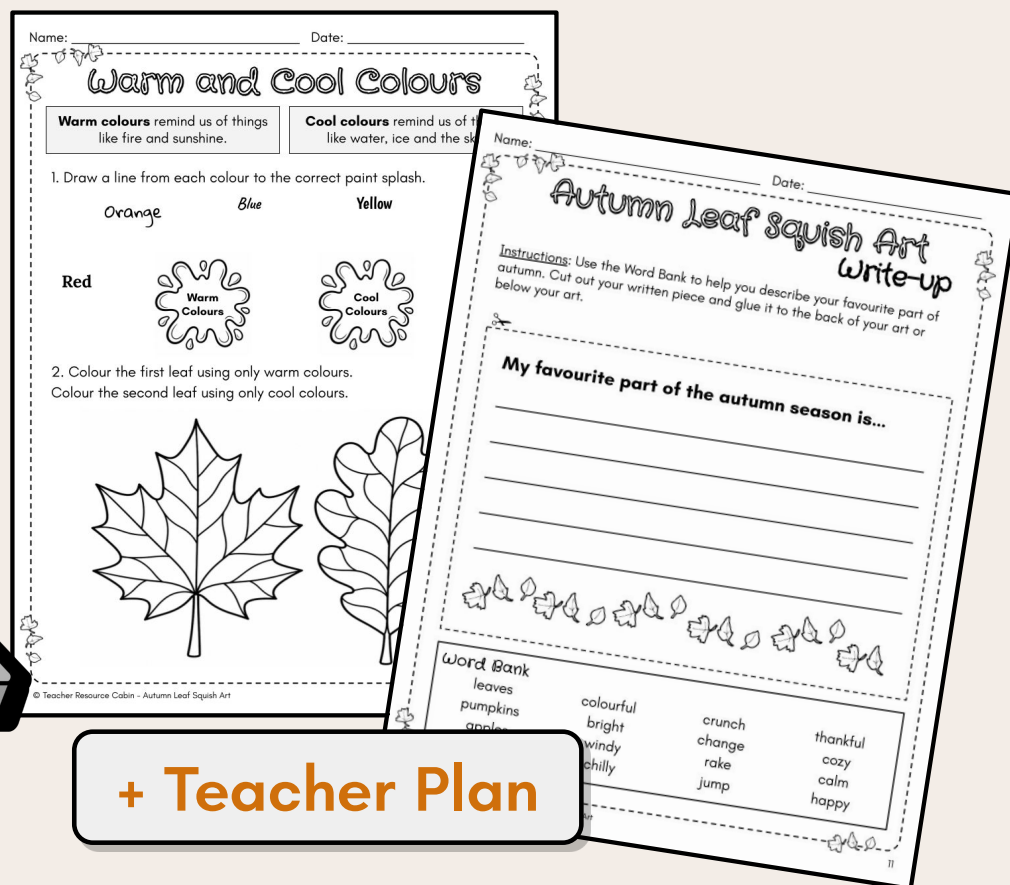

Cool colours remind us of things like water, ice and the sky.

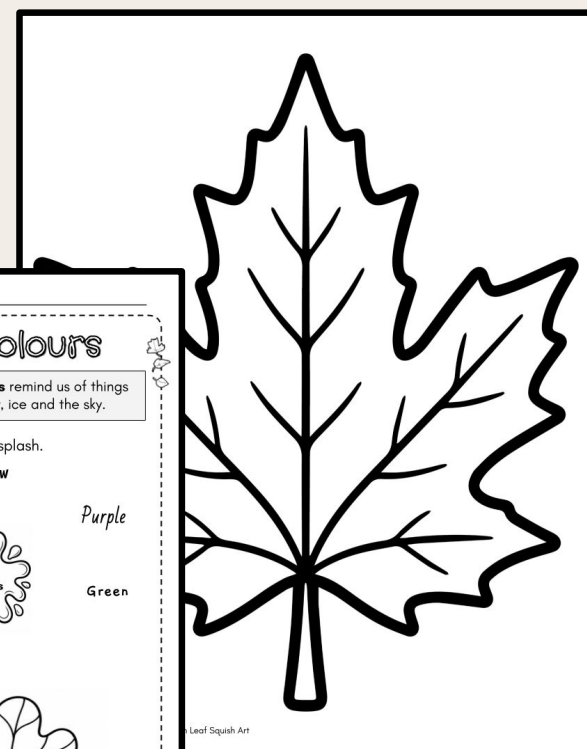
1. Draw a line from each colour to the correct paint splash.

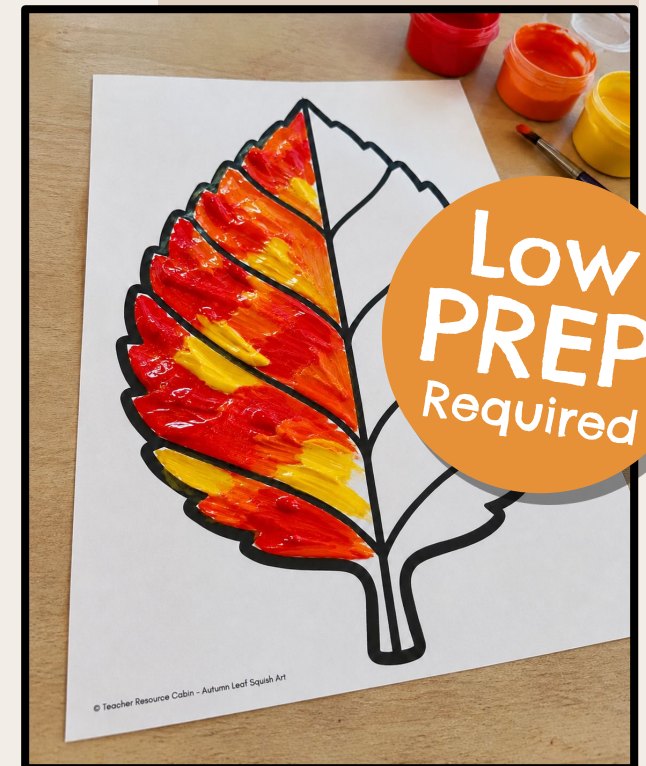


Autumn Leaf Squish Art Project

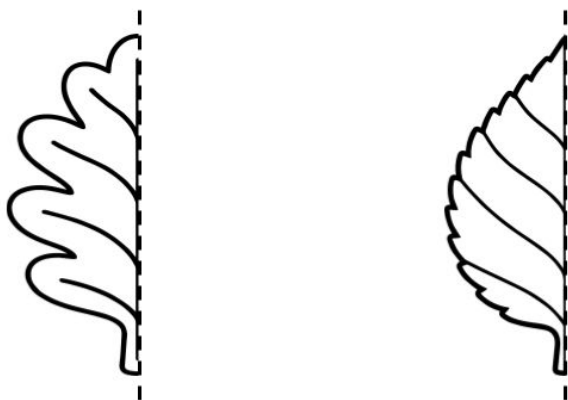
